As we begin this new year of religious education, please be assured that the staff at Saints Peter and Paul Catholic Church and the volunteers in our Confirmation program are dedicated to helping your children grow in faith and draw nearer to the Lord. As parents, you are the primary educators of your children and are their best teachers. Your children learn the most from the example you set when you pray together and actively participate in Mass and the sacraments as a family.

Your Confirmation student will be taking a journey over the next few months, learning about: Proof of God's existence, What it means to be Human; The purpose of Life; Salvation History, the Person of Jesus Christ, the Catholic Church and her Sacraments, particularly the Sacrament of Confirmation. These basic tenants of our Catholic faith are explained in age-appropriate language, lessons are reinforced with activities and scripture and the faith concepts are connected to life experiences in the church and family. Saints Peter and Paul Catholic Church is committed to providing a safe environment for all our students. Confirmation Program Guidelines – 10th and 11th Grades

Confirmation classes will be from 9am-10am. Candidates will be encouraged to attend the 10am Sunday Mass but can attend any weekend Masses to fulfil their weekly Mass commitment. If Mass is not attended weekly, it is the **same** as missing classes.

If your child needs to be picked up, parents are asked to wait for their children outside of the Parish Hall building. Please do not pick up children early.

Students are to attend **all** classes and are to report on time. If an absence is unavoidable, please call the Parish Office to report the absence. As our time of formation is truncated, only ONE absence is permitted for the year. If your child is absent, the missing material must be made up before the student can be confirmed.
